

The policies set forth herein are directives adopted by the Allure Waikiki AOUO Board of Directors to be carried out accordingly by the Allure Front Desk Ambassadors and the Management Office. If you have any suggestions on how to improve a policy or procedure, please put them in writing and they will be reviewed by the Board. Unless and until the Board votes to revise them, you must comply with current policies and procedures, otherwise notifications and/or fines may be issued to your Unit. The purpose of this policy is to establish a uniform set of guidelines and procedures which will be used by the Management Office and Front Desk Ambassadors to decrease the likelihood of issues and to promote the safety and security of all Employees and Residents since our resources are limited. The rules and regulations set forth in this policy supersede and replace all rules and regulations set forth previously.

Hours:

The Swimming Pool is open from 5 AM until 9:45 PM daily. Before 8 AM, please be sure to respect the Quiet Hours.

Etiquette:

When in the Swimming Pool Area, please observe the following etiquette guidelines:

- Demonstrate courtesy, respect, & politeness to other Residents.
- Refrain from yelling, using profanity, and making unnecessary noise. Avoid activities or practices that may annoy other Residents or interfere with their enjoyment of the swimming pool.
- For their safety, supervise children under the age of 12.

Swimming Pool Posted Rules:

- The Pool Area is intended for use by Registered Residents of Allure Waikiki. A maximum of 6 Visitors is allowed per Unit, and must be accompanied by a Resident.
- NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY! Swim at your own risk. The "buddy" system is recommended at all times.
- Keep Pool Area gate locked at all times. For safety purposes, never prop gates open.
- ABSOLUTELY NO diving, running, pushing, spitting, blowing of the nose, is horseplay, or similar behavior permitted. This includes standing on the dividing wall between the pools. No jumping from any of the edges of the pool when other people are in the pool.
- Floats, inflatable items, or any other objects of this nature are NOT permitted, with the exception
 of flotation devices (such as water wings) being used for safety purposes. Small diver toys,
 nonprojectile toys, and squirt toys may be used sensibly. If they interfere with enjoyment of others,
 they may not be used.
- All persons must shower before entering the pool or spa, after the application of lotions or oils, or after returning from the restroom.



- No food, alcoholic beverages, or glassware is allowed in the Pool Area. Non-alcoholic beverages
 only may be consumed outside of the swimming pool. Intoxicated persons are not permitted to use
 the pool.
- No pets (other than Assistance Animals accompanied by their handlers) are allowed in the Pool Area at any time.
- Only persons dressed in standard swimwear are allowed in the Pool Area. Special swim diapers must be worn when necessary to prevent contamination.
- Immoral, lewd, or indecent conduct in the Pool Area is not permitted.
- Portable music devices are permitted only when used with headphones.
- Be sure to dry off completely before entering the Fitness Center or Inside Corridors.
- Owners are responsible for the conduct of their family members, Visitors, and Occupants.
